## School Store

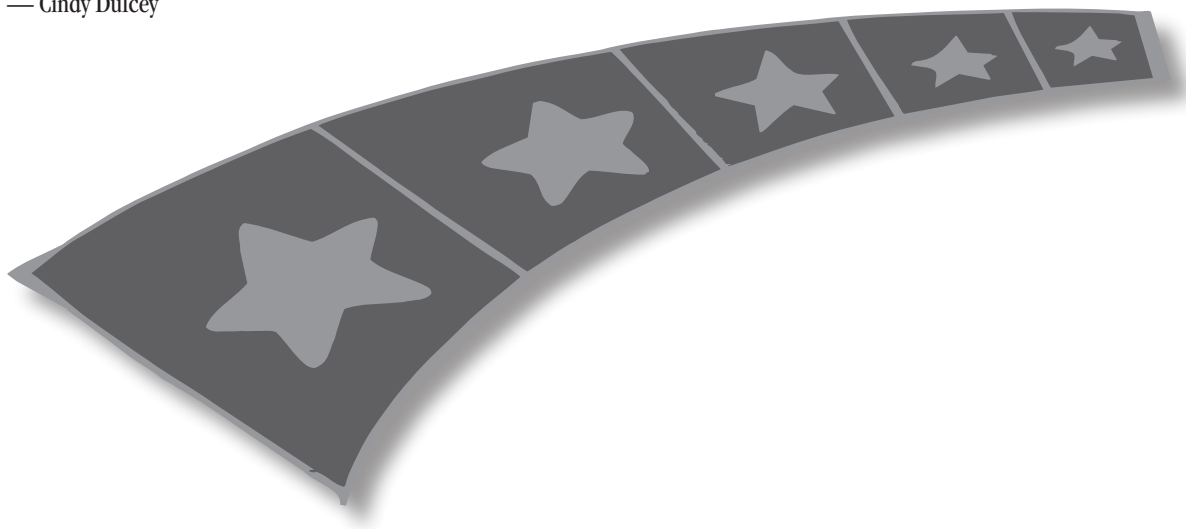
